Best Practice No. 1

Title of the Practice- Social Awareness Program

Context - The deprived social elements other than the urban and rural population are part and parcel of our society. The students must understand these facts. Nearby society is socially and economically backward, so most of the college students coming from these areaes are socially and economically backward.

The practice - Social Awareness committee works to create the social bonding among staff, students and society. These activities are run by the committee from last 15 years. The visits are organized to villages for various purpose such as to help the needy and for the appreciation of the work of frontline workers working in the Covid-19 pandemic. In this context four activities were organized by the department.

- 1. Appreciation of the frontline workers
- 2. Student Welfare Fund
- 3. Distribution of clothes among flood victims of Ridhora
- 4. Spreading awareness regarding Covid-19 pandemic by Pamphlet Distribution
