





# How to Apply

- The applicant has to apply for admission only through the prescribed form available with this prospectus.
- The prospectus, identity card and information brochure may be purchased from the college office.
- Parents/Father's/Mother's undertaking is compulsory.
- Students must write their detailed address and contact number on the admission form.
- The application received after the last date specified by the university may be entertained only after the permission from the university and is subject to the availability of seats for the particular course.
- The following documents (duly attested photostat copies) must accompany the prescribed application form. (Before submitting the original certificates in the college, students should take out photo copies of the documents for their convienence)
- (i) Mark sheet (ii) Character Certificate (iii) Caste Certificate (certified by competent authority for the candidates from reserved categories)
- (iv) Leaving / Transfer Certificate (TC) (Original Certificate of Institute last attended. Duplicate TC will not be entertained)
- (v) Medical Certificate from civil surgeon in case of physically handicaped students (indicating the nature and percentage of disability)
- (vi) Migration Certificate: (for the applicants from other universities) (vii) Equivalence Certificate for students from universities other than Amravati Universitys, (without the equivalence certificate the admission cannot be confirmed) (viii) Latest passport size photograph

# Rules & Regulations For Students

- Students will have to apply for enrolment in specific format only. H.S.S.C. passed candidate will have to pay enrolment fee with enrolment application. A private student securing his/her admission in the college will have to submit enrolment form. Application for enrolment should be submitted on or before last date as notified. After the last date late fee will be charged according to the university rules.
- 75% attendance in each class & subject is necessary, otherwise he/she will not be allowed to appear for university examination, if student is absent for 7 days continuously without permission, he/she may be terminated from the college.
- Students may collect identity card from the office, after producing admission-receipt. If necessary, students will have to show identity card in the library, laboratory or office. If original identity card is lost, students will get new identity card by paying Rs. 10/-
- Without the permission of the college the students must not give any information related to the college to the news paper or any where else.
- Above mentioned Rules & University rules are binding on the students 5)
- The Principal reserves his right to accept or reject the admission & it is not binding on him to show reasons for that.
- Students will get Train/S.T. Concession on the basis of permanent address, which he/she has mentioned on the application form. Students should give local address in detail. Change of address should be informed to the office.
- Students should keep his/her bicycle/scooter on the cycle stand. Students will have to pay amount to the contractor. In case of breakage, it will be the contractor's responsibility & not of the college.
- Under graduate students will have to go for medical check up by the college appointed medical officer and also will have to appear for Physical Efficiency Test.
- Test exams will be conducted by the college before Diwali and after Diwali. All the rules of the exams should be strictly followed.
- It will be the students responsibility to see that, his/her admission is according to the university rules. Students Admission will be cancelled if he/she has furnished false information or documents.



#### Instructions for Students

- ▶ Students should not break or damage college property, otherwise he/she will have to pay its price along with the fine to the college.
- If student is found responsible for damaging the college property like college building, electricity, windows, fans, furniture, etc. He/she will have to pay fine according to the direction by the Principal.

## Instructions for Parents

## Important Instructions About Fees

- 1) As given in the prospectus, students will have to pay all fees at the time of his/her admission. If admission is cancelled for any reason, in such circumstances, fees will not refund/full fee has to be paid.
- 2) After taking admission in the college, it will be the students' responsibility to pay the fees. If student does not come or leaves the college, in such condition it will binding to student to pay all fees.
- 3) If student does not pay the fees till the last date, his admission may be cancelled. It will be Principal's discretion to give or reject the admission.
- 4) After securing admission in one faculty, if student wants to change the faculty, in such condition he/she will have to pay admission fee & other fees again. Student will have to pay all the fees and dues before examination.
- 5) If the students are getting the advantage of A.T.K.T., in such condition Government rules about fees (E.B.C.) will be binding on the students.



# Conditions to Seek G.O.I. Scholarships, Freeships, Free Studentship & Concessions

- Merit scholarship for the wards of primary and secondary school teachers, for a continuous course the scholar must secure promotion to the next higher class in each University examination. At the completion stage, the scholar must obtain a first class or 60% marks in the aggregate.
- 2) Scholarship for the wards of freedom fighters (Minimum 50% marks in the examination).
- 3) Govt. of India post S.S.C. Scholarship for the B.C. (SC, ST, NT, etc) students (promotion to next higher class).
- 4) Govt. of India National Scholarship (as per Govt. rules)
- 5) Scholarship for physically handicapped students (certificate from the civil surgeon must accompanying the application form).
- 6) Free tuition for the students of economically backward classes (E.B.C.) (Promotion to next higher class) (annual income: upto Rs. 15000/-).
- 7) G.O.I./O.B.C Scholarship
- 8) Free ship OBC concession (Annual Income limit: Rs. 70000/to Rs. 250000/-).


#### Conditions to Seek Concessions

- Scholarship is based on satisfactory progress, regular attendance and conduct of the scholar. If it is reported to the Head of the Institution
  that a scholar has by reasons of his/her own act or default failed to show satisfactory progress or found guilty in his/her conduct such as
  resorting to or participating in strikes, irregularity in attendance, the authority may cancel the scholarship or stop or withhold further
  payments.
- 2. (A) All backward class students (SC/ST/NT etc.) are considered eligible for the Govt. of India Scholarship as per Govt. rules. (B) In case of refundable fees and other fees, if the fees are not reimbursed from the Govt., The student will have to pay it to the college. (C) Scholarships will be paid to the students according to the Government rules.
- 3. (A) Students with a break in studies should submit a gap certificate in the form of an affidavit stating the reasons for the gap. (B) Students who have received the scholarship of the Govt. of india in the previous year and have passed the annual examination are also required to submit the application forms. Their cases will be reported to the Divisional Social Welfare Officer, Amravati by the college for the renewal of scholarships.
- 4. E.B.C. Concession: Students whose parents income is less than Rs. 15000/- p.a. are declared economically backward. Their fees are reimbursed by the State Government. However, such students have to apply in the prescribed form (to be obtained from the college office) to gether with an income certificate signed by the Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar and an attested true copy of marksheet of the last examination immediately after he/she is admitted to the college. E.B.C. concession will be finally decided at the end of the session on the basis of regular attendance which should not be less than 75% and satisfactory progress in the unit tests and test examinations.
- 5. Application forms for EBC, PTC and other concessions are available in the market. Applicants should fill in such forms and submit them to the college with necessary documents at the time of admission.
- 6. If a student fails to submit the concerned scholarship form in the time, He/She himself/herself will be responsible for not getting the scholarship.






